Welcome to this evening's public scoping meeting. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) is seeking input related to GLMRIS from stakeholders, tribes and members of the public throughout the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) scoping period. The comment period for NEPA scoping will close on March 31, 2011.

GLMRIS will explore options and technologies, collectively known as aquatic nuisance species (ANS) controls, that could be applied to prevent ANS transfer between the basins through aquatic pathways. **Using input obtained during the scoping period, USACE will refine GLMRIS to focus on significant issues, as well as eliminate issues that are not significant from further detailed study.
