Because of the threat Asian carp pose to our Great Lakes region, identifying prevention opportunities should be completed for all 18 pathways, not just a handful of them;

- While implementing prevention strategies, such as the creation of barriers, may not be necessary at the moment, having these tactics identified will best prepare us to act quickly and stop the spread of Asian carp if the threat grows; and
 - Risk reduction activities, such as monitoring, should include some sort of “trigger” or “threshold” at which the threat is no longer consider “low” and serves as a signal that taking action on the identified prevention strategies is recommended.
- If the threat level is no longer "low" please save our lakes from devastation by acting quickly. The time for action is near, please do not hesitate too long and allow the degradation of the natural ecology currently found in our lakes.
