Ask the Army Corps to shorten their study – waiting until 2015 is not acceptable.

- Close the locks in the Chicago Area Waterways System this year on a temporary basis while determining how to continue Chicago Waterways commercial transportation as well as sewage disposal.
- Urge the Army Corps to collaborate on the study to be completed this year by the Great Lakes Commission and the Great Lakes and St. Lawrence Cities Initiative. They plan to present options for separating the two watersheds by January 2012.
- Push back the barriers in the Chicago Waterways to keep Asian Carp and other invasive species further away from the Great Lakes.
- Asian Carp threaten the Great Lakes from other waterways in addition to the Chicago Waterways. Urge the Army Corps to effect a permanent separation on these waterways.
