I urge the Army Corps of Engineers to help find a permanant solution to preventing Asian Carp from entering the Great Lakes. Please:

1.Study only solutions that will completely prevent the movement of invasive species between the Great Lakes and Mississippi River, and

2. Provide answers for the Chicago portion of the study within 18 months.

Other invasive species that have impacted the Great Lakes, such as zebra mussels and the sea lamprey, have had a tremendous adverse impact on the ecosystem health of these waterways.
