I am writing to voice my concerns about the potential threat of Asian Carp to the sportfishing and tourism industries of Lake Michigan. I am concerned that, without physical separation of the Chicago waterway from Lake Michigan, there will be no viable solution to this problem.

From what I have learned, it appears that USACE's study and potential "solutions" are literally years down the road...they have proposed no viable solution at this point in time, and meanwhile, the Asian Carp population continues to progress ever closer to Lake Michigan.

I am left to question the degree of your commitment to preventing the spread of Asian Carp into the Great Lakes. Many dozen invasive species have already entered Lake Michigan, and Asian Carp would be another huge blow to this ecosystem.

I urge you to act immediately to put in place a viable physical separation technique to forestall this threat.
