The current barrier method of preventing Asian Carp from infiltrating Lake Michigan is not adequate. The idea that there needs to be three years of study to improve the method is unacceptable. It is universally well known that invasive species are the most pervasive and destructive of ecosystems. They have few if any predators, competitors, or natural limits on their reproduction. Lake Michigan is too vulnerable to an invasion by such an aggressive species as the Asian Carp. The results will most certainly decimate sport fishing populations.
